### Objective:

Artistic residencies should stimulate peer-to-peer exchange of ideas, experience and artistic skills, and provide participants with the opportunity to meet, interact and work together in a culturally diverse and inspiring environment. By fostering cultural mobility and cooperation, the awarded artistic residencies will stimulate regional partnerships as well as quality co-production of multicultural contents, which in the long run will enrich intercultural dialogue and creativity in the WBs region.

Residencies will equip participants with knowledge and skills on how to create artistic expressions using multimedia tools and how to access the WBs and EU markets. Artistic residencies will also envisage workshops and talks with speakers from the WBs on various topics, including the professional status of artists and the improvement of their economic and social working conditions in light of the specific WBs context.

### Your application should provide us with the following information:

- 1. Who are you?
- 2. Where are you going?
- 3. Why are you going?
- 4. When are you planning to travel? Please ensure that your application is submitted at <u>least three months</u> prior to the expected travelling date.
- 5. What is the duration of your stay abroad? Note that the duration of your project cannot be longer than 3 months (this includes preparation, travelling and accommodation expenses, participation fees, any other costs strictly related to your stay, and final reporting).

This Open Call for Applications is continuously open until 30 June 2026! The evaluation committee will convey during the first week of every month for applications received by the end of the previous month. Note that the actual project implementation can take place as latest by end of September 2026.







### 1. Eliminatory criterion:

The applicant must be resident in one of the Western Balkans IPA Beneficiaries<sup>2</sup>. This shall be proved through the submission of a copy of your valid Identity Card.

### VI CONTRACTING

Each selected grantee whose application is approved will have to undertake a due diligence process as per the requirements of the Organisers of Call, following which a contract will be signed, regulating all aspects of implementation, transfer of funds, reporting and monitoring. Any legal actions related to the obligations of either party shall be regulated in the contract, following the award of the grant to the successful applicant.

- → The recipient of the Small Grant will sign the contract with the respective Contractor<sup>3</sup>.

Successful applicants will be instructed to follow <u>"EU visibility guidelines for external actions"</u> as all communication and visibility activities implemented under the framework of the CC4WBs programme will seek to ensure synergy with the EU Communication Strategy.

Successful applicants will also be instructed to use the CC4WBS visual identity in all applicable occasions during the implementation of their activities through the Small Grant. Visual identity guidelines will be shared with the successful applicants.


